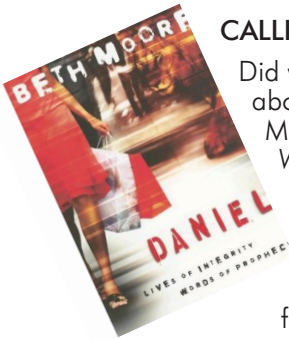
## **SPRING RETREAT - Blockade Runner, Wrightsville Beach April 13 – 15, 2012**

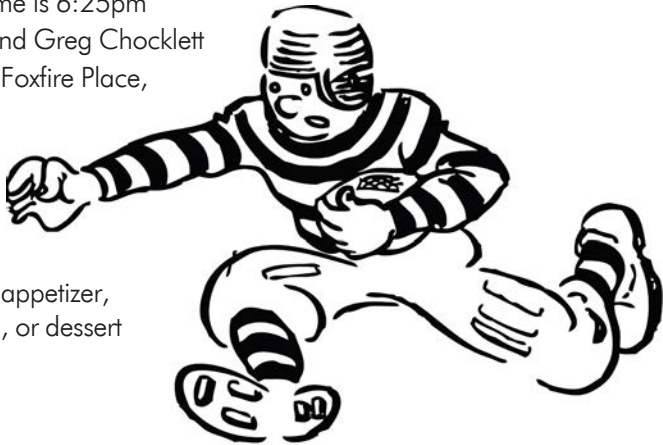

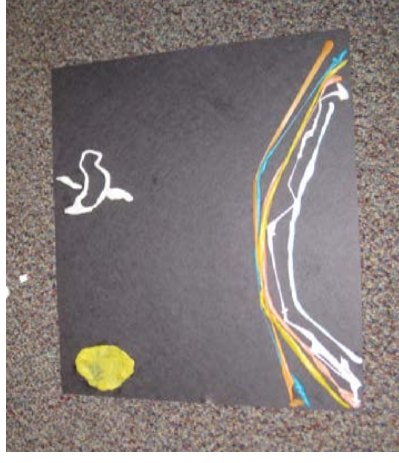
